

A 6-storey high phone mast outside the shops on Wulfstan Way? We need to say what we think.

Dear Wulfstan Way resident

I wanted to let you know urgently about a planning application which has been submitted to install an 18m mobile phone mast plus various bits of supporting equipment outside of the shops on Wulfstan Way. In case you are struggling to visualise that, on the right is a mock-up of what it will look like – 18m (or 60 feet) tall is the equivalent of a 6-storey building, and will be considerably taller than the tallest trees planted there. The plans show the supporting equipment in a 6m stretch on the pavement, with the tallest cabinet being almost 2m (or 6 feet) tall.



Local residents and businesses have worked so hard during the last year to bring some life to our 'village green' – people have been litter picking, gardening, installing the book exchange, painting outside the shops and putting in new seating. This planning application would overshadow the site. In addition, I know one of the frustrations of local businesses is that, despite their best efforts, it's hard for them to be seen by passers-by due to them being set back under the flats. A run of tall cabinets further shielding them from view will not help them to thrive.

It's important that we all say what we think about the planning application. In each case below, the reference we need to quote is 21/01386/PRI16A and we can:
